

Joining the RCC Dream Team

1. Receive training in the ministry area of your choice
2. Fill out the Dream Team Leadership Application
3. Meet with a ministry leader to finalize your place on the team

Life Group Leadership

This team is the heart of RCC, because we are a church of small groups and we believe that the best place for sustained life change to occur is in the context of intentional relationships. Along with facilitating group meetings, this role also provides shepherding and care for a group of 5-12 people. Apprenticeship in a prior Life Group required.

Waumba Land (Birth – 5 years old)

Creating a fun and safe environment on Sundays where children (birth – 5 years old) can learn three basic truths: God made me. God loves me. Jesus wants to be my friend forever. Each week, children experience Bible Story time, music, crafts, and other hands-on activities. Various roles include teacher, small group leader, assistant, check-in, and environment setup. Background check required.

Upstreet (K – 5th grades)

Upstreet is an exciting environment on Sundays, that partners with parents, to teach children about God and seeks to introduce them to a personal relationship with Jesus. Large group worship and a Bible story is followed by small group interaction--all to communicate God's truth through worship, dance, Bible story, and hands-on activities. Various roles include actors, worship, dancers, small group leader, assistant, check-in, and environment setup. Background check required.

Switch (6th – 12th grades)

Switch JV is 6th – 9th grades and meets on Sundays. Switch V is 10th – 12th grades and usually meets on Monday nights.

Relational connections with students and involvement in their lives are key to teaching them about God and connecting them to a ministry that will change their life. Various roles include teacher, small group leader, assistant, worship, and environment setup. Background check required.

Kidstuf

Monthly high-energy theater environment where parents and kids (K-5th grade) come together to learn about God. The virtue for the month is introduced and communicated through actors, dancers, and music. Various roles include actors, dancers, vocalists, setup, crowd control, food team, and production. Auditions required for most roles.

KidCare

A safe environment created for the children of volunteers that enables parents to “work one, worship one”. Background check required.

Family Ministry Host

A team that welcomes and ensures the security of children as they are checked in and out of Family Ministry environments.

Connection Prep Team

This team puts together the Connection and other information for Sunday morning, so that attendees can take notes, keep up with current events, and worship God with their giving.

Host Team

This team focuses on creating a warm and welcoming environment for people to attend. Whether is it helping with traffic flow, greeting people warmly, helping people find a seat, or setting up the coffee bar. These are the official "hosts and

hostesses" of RCC and their responsibility is to create a GREAT first impression.

Prayer Team

People who commit to pray weekly for the prayer requests that are turned in. They take seriously the important role of interceding for individuals, leaders, the lost, and RCC as a whole. Some individuals are also available in front of the stage after each service to pray with individuals about a burden they carry or a commitment they are making.

Band

This team works to enhance the weekend environments so that people can connect with God through worship. The band is always looking for new talent. Auditions are required.

Production

The team that makes each environment happen. With roles ranging from lights and sound, to camera and computer graphics (CG), we are always looking for new talent to help create irresistible environments. Roles are available on Sundays and during the week.

Office Assistant

Individuals who serve during the week in the office, answering phones, data entry, and compiling materials for various ministries.

Resources

Team that services the resource center on Sundays and during the week to provide books, audio CDs, and other resources to aid people's growth.

Growth Track

This team has a passion to help people take the next step spiritually as they host the Growth Track steps. Roles include host, food team, media & sound.

Grounds & Maintenance

This team honors God by keeping our facilities and grounds in great shape. They see their behind-the-scenes roles as a way to worship God and inspire people. It makes people say, "Wow, someone prepared for me to come." Roles include lawn care, landscaping, repairs, painting, & new projects.

Care/Visitation

This team is made up of people who love to meet physical and emotional needs. They will visit people in hospitals and nursing homes, respond in time of death or tragedy, and are there to provide genuine care in time of need.
